COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT/ TRAINING:

- Provided standby coverage for swinging for Willie charity softball tournament
- EMS Chief Jessie Myers has been asked to chair the committee for the Weatherford Regional Hospital Foundation Golf Tournament
- Provided standby Weatherford 4th of July celebration.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:

- Lifeguard provided standby coverage and rehab for Hydro Fire Department during a residential structure fire.
- Lifeguard also provided standby for possible structure fire at the First National Bank building in Weatherford.
- The Lifeguard Team assisted Weatherford Fire Department with an extended high angle extrication of a patient.



JOINT TRAINING:

- Lifeguard provided CPR training to 14 community residents to increase the chance of early activation of the system with bystander CPR.
- Lifeguard continues to work with the Hydro Fire Department to get individual medical protocols in place. This will allow the Firefighters with advanced licensure to perform a higher level of care prior to Lifeguard's arrival on scenes.
