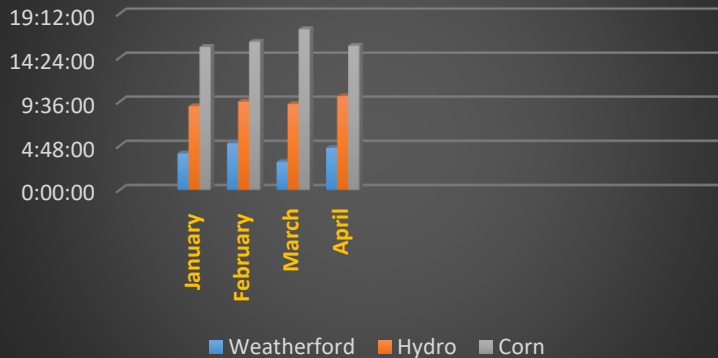

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:
