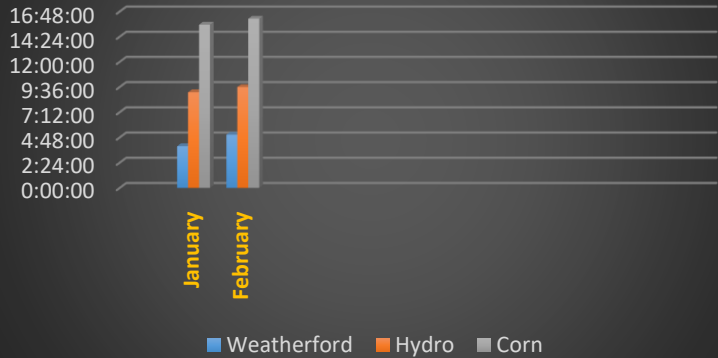

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:

- **SOUTHWEST OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY PHARMACY DEPARTMENT BLS/CPR COURSE:** The Lifeguard Team provided a make-up course for eleven (11) Pharmacy students for the Basic Life Support – Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation for Health Care Providers this month. In all, 100% of the Pharmacy Students met the BLS/CPR requirement for their program.
- **WEATHERFORD AND HYDRO FIRE DEPARTMENT IN-SERVICE TRAINING – NREMT Refresher:** Members of the Lifeguard Team provided all Continuing Education requirements and managed the paperwork for recertifying 100% of the Weatherford and Hydro Fire Fighters due to recertify through the National Registry in 2019. This action also satisfied the Oklahoma State Health Department requirements for state licensure.
