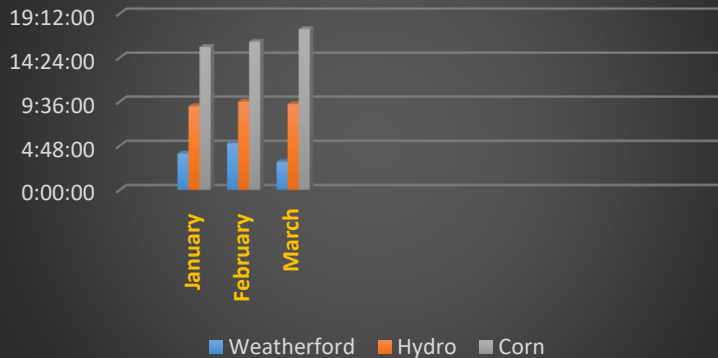

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:

- **NATIONAL SCHOOL BREAKFAST WEEK:** Members of the Lifeguard Team participated in serving breakfast to students at East Elementary and the Weatherford High School. All together, the Team served approximately 160 students, and enjoyed the opportunity to visit with the School Staff and Kids.
- **OKLAHOMA REGION 1 RMRS – MERC SURGICAL EXTRACTION TEAM (SET) EXERCISE:** Chief Gower and his Team participated in Classroom Instruction followed by a Practical Exercise, learning the decision making process of when to access the SET. The Medical Team, comprised of members from Hydro and Weatherford Fire Departments, as well as Lifeguard EMS, engaged in a simulated person trapped underneath construction equipment. The Team performed initial life-sustaining techniques that would be required in an actual event. The Team interacted with the SET and AIREVAC Team Members, all focused on extricating the impinged patient. A hotwash was completed at ENDEX, identifying strengths and opportunities for improvement. Overall, the exercise was very educational for all participants.
