


#### THANKSGIVING TURKEY AND DRESSING (CROCK POT)

- 2 pounds boneless skinless turkey breast whole or in chunks
- 1 box (6 oz) stuffing mix whichever is your favorite
- 1 can (10.5 oz) cream of chicken soup
- 3/4 cup sour cream
- 1 cup chicken stock

Gather your ingredients together. Spray crockpot with cooking spray. Place turkey in the bottom of the crockpot and season with salt, pepper and whatever seasoning you like. In a mixing bowl mix together the cream of chicken soup, sour cream and stock. Gently stir in the stuffing, Spread it on top of the turkey. Cover and cook on high for 4 hours.


