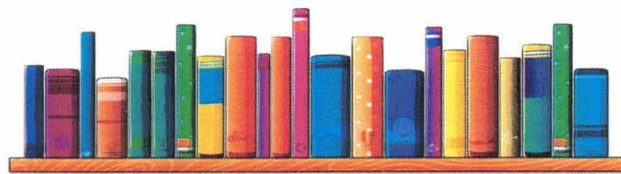

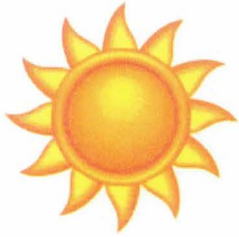
WALK THE HALLS
